Inclusion & inclusive education in policy

SDGs:

- "4.5: By 2030, [...] ensure **equal access to all levels of education** and vocational training for the vulnerable, including persons with disabilities, indigenous peoples and children in vulnerable situations"
- "10.2: By 2030, empower and promote the social, economic and political inclusion of all, irrespective of age, sex, disability, race, ethnicity, origin, religion or economic or other status"

New York Declaration on Refugees and Migrants:

• "23. We recognize and will address, [...], the **special needs of all people in vulnerable situations** [...], including [...] **persons with disabilities** [...]."

Djibouti Declaration:

- "3. Particularly concerned by the disproportionate impact that conflict and forced displacement have on the education of women and girls, and that girls and boys, as well as people with disabilities must have equal access to education and skills training at all levels"
- "27. Respond to the **distinct learning needs of refugee and returnee** boys and girls and ensure they have equitable and **inclusive access to education**."

Principles for Easy to Read Documents

- Use **easy to understand words** that people will know well. If you need to use difficult words, make sure you always **explain them** clearly
- If you have to use abbreviations, explain them. For example, if you write "AU", explain that it stands for "the African Union"
- Always keep sentences short
- Use **active language** rather than passive language where possible
- Many people find it hard to read text. To help them understand your text, you should put **images** next to it to describe what it is about
- Clear design (e.g. font, font size, use of colours etc)



Who benefits from Easy to Read Documents?

- Persons with intellectual disabilities
- Children & youths
- Persons who do not speak a certain language as their native language
- Persons who have not been able to regularly attend formal schooling

1. Refugees.

Refugees are people who have to run away from their home countries because they were unsafe there.



2. Returnees.

Returnees are refugees that go back to their home country.

These promises are written in a document called the Djibouti Declaration on Refugee Education in IGAD Member States.


