



IGAD Extends Condolences to Sudan Following Devastating Landslide in Darfur

September 3, 2025 (Djibouti, Djibouti) - The Executive Secretary of IGAD, H.E. Dr. Workneh Gebeyehu, expresses his deepest condolences to the families and communities affected by the devastating landslide in the Republic of Sudan's North Darfur State, which has claimed more than 1,000 lives and destroyed an entire village in the Marra Mountains.
